Dear Friends,

1919 to 2019. Tranquillity Camp is celebrating its 100th birthday. Few camps can boast such an achievement. What an amazing accomplishment, certainly one to be celebrated by anyone who is now or has been part of the incredible journey that has taken us to today.

From the ten boys Mr. Cohen brought to his farm in "Urlton" in 1919, to the 360 children who attended camp throughout 2019 we certainly have grown. Tranquillity now has over one thousand acres of land, and thanks to the devotion of so many people, Tranquillity's facilities have improved; swimming pools, tennis courts, the Dining Room, Overlook Lane, Frindel Lane, The Hills, the Pearl C. Miller Sports Center, Street Hockey Rink and many more projects were completed. We are indebted to the Marc Cohn and Family, Richard Lawrence and Family and Robin Diamant and the Schlang Family for their dedication to Mr. Cohen and Pearl's vision. Their support throughout the years has been resolute and steadfast.

In 1952," The Tranquillity Alumni" was formed. Pearl recognized the need to create an organization to ensure the preservation of TY. She enlisted a former group of original "Tranquillity-ites" — Al Rukin, Abe Berson, Nat Menis and Leo Skolnik — to fulfill that mission. For over seven decades the Alumni, now called "The Friends of Tranquillity Camp", has been instrumental in helping to provide a rewarding camp experience for thousands of girls and boys fortunate to call TY their summer home.

Since Tranquillity Camp began in 1919 on through today, every boy, every girl, every counselor, every staff member, every parent has become part of the Tranquillity family. A feeling of belonging, of togetherness and "esprit de corps" developed. Each generation of campers became the leaders, training the next group of campers, much like big brothers and sisters. The shows in the barn and sports center, the songs, the spirit on the ball fields and the same traditions have been carried on from one year to the next. Friendships formed at TY remained solid through life. There has always been a feeling of camp pride, of being part of a unique family. Whether you belonged to the groups that Elias A. Cohen brought to his little farm in "Urlton" in the 1920's when camp was small and camp life was simple, or whether you came in the 1930's as Tranquillity developed from a farm to camp, or whether you came during the 1940's when many of the children were refugees who came from the war-torn countries of Europe to find peace and happiness, and learned to become Americans. Then, there were the thousands who came since then, whose lives were profoundly influenced by the wisdom and guidance of Pearl. The Tranquillity-ites of the 21st Century continue to carry on the traditions we hold so dear.

We hope to see you on Visiting Day, August 2, 2020. If you have not been to TY in a while, you will be amazed at how camp has grown, yet at the same time you will remember the Tranquillity Camp you knew many years ago.
