



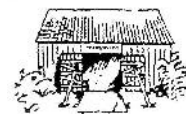

Since Tranquillity Camp began in 1919, on through today, every camper, every counselor, every worker, every parent has become part of the Tranquillity family. The same shows in the barn and sports center, the same songs, the same spirit on the ball fields and the same traditions were carried on from one year to the next. If the name is mentioned anywhere and someone recognizes it, an instant kinship and bond are fostered because of the shared camp experiences.

Over the decades Tranquillity has grown in size and stature. However, we are proud to say we have not changed. We may have more children, new and improved housing, modern facilities, etc., but the essence of Tranquillity has endured as we enter our 97th season. We continue to help those in need, whether from broken homes, financial hardships or just being able to benefit from our unique and rewarding Tranquillity experience. Once again we were able to offer scholarships to military children as our way of thanking their parents for their service to our country. It is through the efforts of the Elias A. Cohen Foundation, The Charles Cohn Foundation, The Lawrence Family, The Schlang Foundation, the members of the Cohen Family, and The Friends of Tranquillity Camp, that we are able to help those less fortunate. Your support of Tranquillity Camp, whether through financial donations, goods and services, or volunteering your time, will ensure that Tranquillity remains in perpetuity as was the life’s work of both Mr. Cohen and Pearl.
