## A MESSAGE FROM RICHARD LAWRENCE

Involvement is at the heart of every Tranquillity-ite. Through all the years, the first implicit requirements on arrival at Camp were to find and check in with Pearl. To a person, each asked "What can I do?" or "How can I help?" Every one. Not all had been campers or staff. Even "adopted" Tranquillity-ites understood that Noblesse Oblige was, and is, a way of life.

Some of the lessons "taught" at Tranquillity each summer were subtle. For many years, the counselor staff was "home-grown," so they spoke to their charges in the same ways as when they were campers. By the end of each summer, any early reluctance to think up an original cheer, stunt or song all but evaporated. Perhaps the realization that the end to that summer's idyllic life induced a preference to extend their stay - even if it meant digging impossibly deep in the well of creation.

Other lessons were imparted more clearly, in talks after services on Friday evenings. It didn't matter where services were held. Most campers overlooked their itchy bug bites and the desire to return to their houses for more chat. When Pearl spoke, almost every camper fell silent, eager to listen to that week's *timeless* lesson.

By coming to tonight's Casino Night/Dinner Dance, each of you has demonstrated your commitment to Tranquillity's future. It is critical that you communicate with every Tranquillity-ite possible and hammer home the point that Tranquillity will not continue unless many more people **give back** to Tranquillity. From the moment the Tranquillity Alumni was formed over 50 years ago, dedicated Tranquillity-ites from all walks of life came together with one purpose - Keep Tranquillity Alive. Without warning, they had to replace the financial backing provided by Elias A. Cohen. They faced an economic abyss and their backs were against the wall. Obviously they succeeded; otherwise Tranquillity would not be here today.

I believe that Tranquillity has reached a "tipping point." As the years have passed, each succeeding generation all but pounded on the door, asking "How can I help? Or "What can I do?" I want to do something - anything - to try to repay Tranquillity for helping to make me into a better person - the person I am today. I sense a "disconnect" with far too many people, who believe themselves to be true Tranquillity-ites, thinking that Tranquillity will continue on without any effort on their part. After all, that's the way it (seems to) have been for many years.

Well, the time has come for every Tranquillity-ite to step up and give back. Help can come in many forms. We need more campers deserving of the Tranquillity experience; if needed, scholarship assistance from outside sources is certainly a possibility. Contributions from those who are able are incredibly valuable. Working to secure company ads in the Friends of TY Journal is another way to accumulate a (large) total annual contribution from diversified sources. Working to secure donations of items, such as medical & art supplies, sporting equipment or food used at Camp is another great way to help. I believe that such contributions are entitled to a charitable deduction.

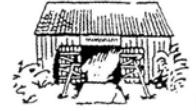

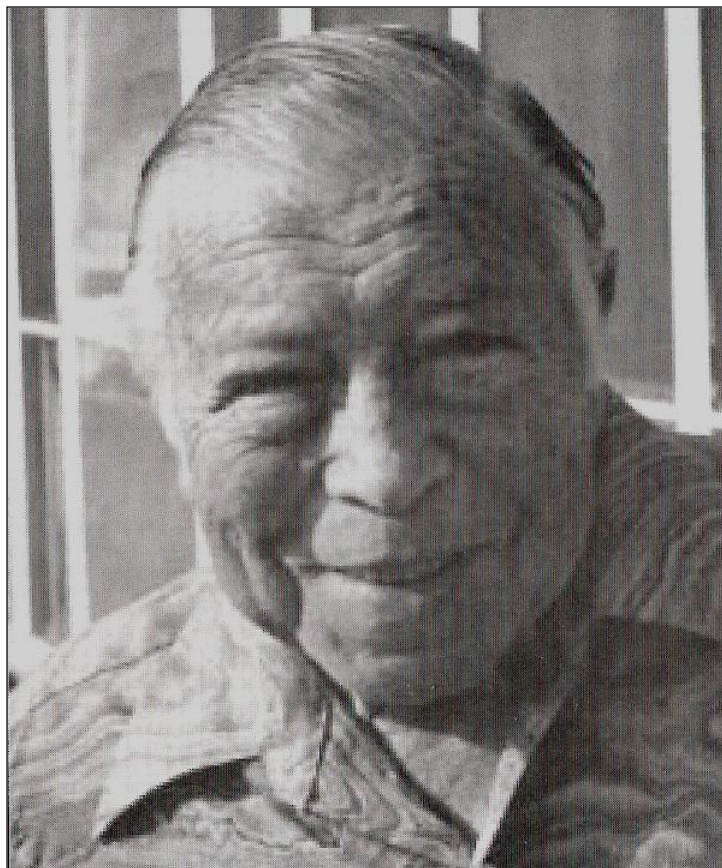

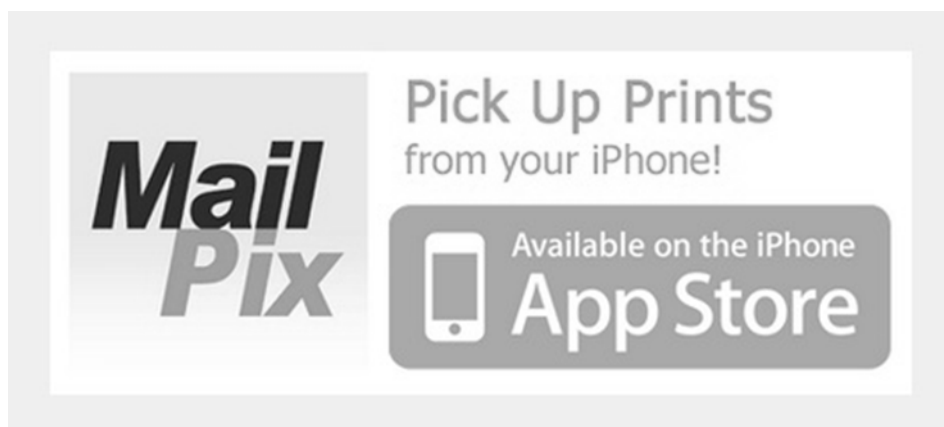
